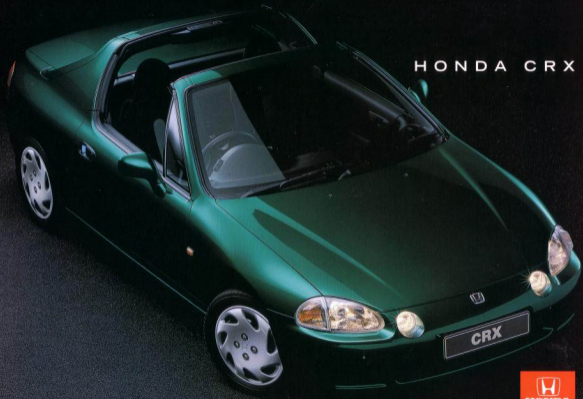


HONDA CRX





The CRX - a revolution in sports cars

In typical Honda fashion, the CRX borrows from no one.

It's an exciting thoroughbred compact sports car, using the latest technology and everything Honda has learned from a decade of Formula One motor racing success, to create a truly original sports car.

At the heart of this is Honda's revolutionary 16 valve VTEC engine which produces a superbly smooth and effortless delivery of power and torque - without sacrificing fuel efficiency.

The single overhead cam-shaft powerplant develops 123bhp. A 5 speed manual gearbox is standard with a short travel gear lever for positive, smooth gear changes.

The ride is supple but tautly controlled, thanks to Honda's double-wishbone suspension system. Add to that power assisted steering and all-round disc brakes and you have poise, balance and handling finesse.

Exciting sports car driving is matched by ingenious sports car design.

Honda's solution to stowing the roof is, typically, as ingenious as it is original, and can be accomplished at the touch of a button. So you can have all the advantages of a convertible with all the security and comfort of a hardtop.



The CRX can become an open top sports car at the touch of a button.



1. The boot lid rises to roof level...



2. ...the roof is tilted up and slides backwards...



3. ...and is placed in the boot behind.



4. The boot lid lowers and clicks shut.
The whole process takes just 45 seconds!

The CRX delivers a style and excitement that few sports cars can match.



Total open top motoring: an electrically operated rear window can be lowered to increase the air flow.

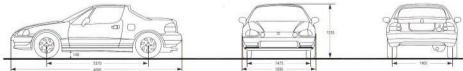

One of the many advantages of becoming a Honda owner is the PRIDE handover. Before you drive away we make sure that you are completely familiar with your new car and the range of services provided by your Honda dealer.

The PRIDE handover includes:

- A personal introduction to your new car
- An 80 point pre-delivery inspection Check
- The vehicle document wallet, "At Your Service" book and Pride FM cassette
- The finance documents (if applicable)
- Insurance Certificates and Road Fund Licence
- An introduction to key members of staff and a tour of the dealership (if requested)

Your dealer will also explain the three Honda warranties:

1. **A 2-year unlimited mileage mechanical warranty** covers your Honda against any defects in materials or workmanship however far you drive in that time.
2. **A 3-year surface corrosion warranty** guarantees the paintwork of your car against defects in materials or workmanship.
3. **A 6-year rust through corrosion warranty** covers the body panels and structural parts of your car against perforation caused by corrosion from the inside out (excluding the exhaust system and catalytic converter).
